October	<p><b>Y7 Introduction and Team Building Activities</b>                      Introduction – launch programme, set out expectations.                      Team Building - Getting to know each other.</p>
March	<p><b>Y7 STEM Challenge</b>                      Students will develop a project to pitch in a 'Dragon's Den' style competition to a team of STEM specialists.</p>
November	<p><b>Y8 University Challenge Quiz</b>                      Challenging questions, specialist subjects and general knowledge.                      Students compete in groups in a University Challenge Quiz.</p>
January	<p><b>Y10 Brilliant Club</b>                      Experience of university-style learning in small group tutorials. Engage in their own research project led by a PhD tutor. Two visits to highly selective universities</p>
October	<p><b>Y9 DofE Launch Assembly</b>                      Build confidence, resilience, skills for work and friendship groups.</p>
February	<p><b>Y9 Debating Club</b>                      Students will improve their confidence, general knowledge and learn to question their beliefs as part of the Debating Club. They will polish up on their presentation skills, undertake topical research, learn how to influence others and reflect on a balanced point of view.</p>
November	<p><b>Y9 Young Enterprise</b>                      Students will work through a series of real-life business tasks to help find a solution. They will act as advisors to the company and help them decide best to approach the challenge. Working in teams they will develop key skills such as problem solving, creativity, team work, communication, leadership and confidence.</p>
